



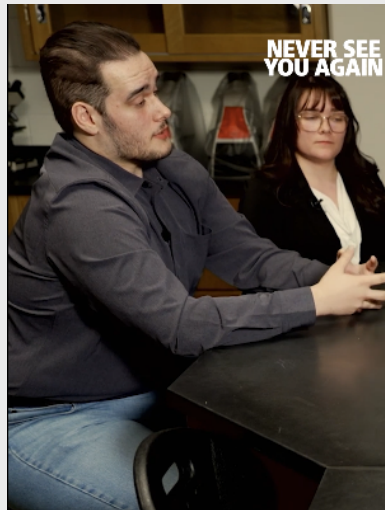

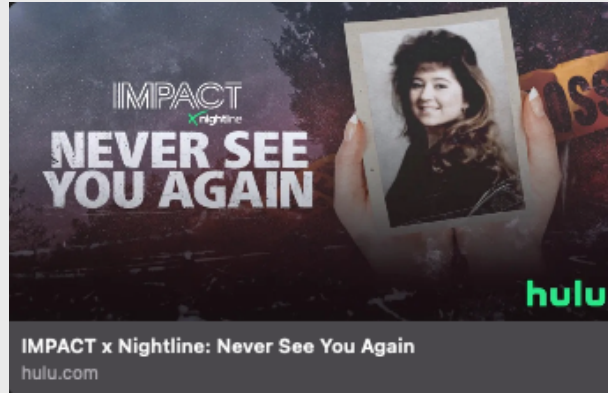

*At the University of Texas at Arlington, students in a new criminology class all have dreams of solving crimes, but few of them thought it would happen so soon. Decades have gone by and the trail to finding the killer of Cynthia Gonzalez had gone cold, until the students found a name buried deep inside the police case file. John Quiñones reports in our latest episode "Never See You Again" — from IMPACT x Nightline.*

Cheers to Professor Patricia Eddings and her students. The 34-minute episode is must-watch TV, bringing the case to life and showing how students put fresh eyes on a decades-old murder investigation, connecting details no one else had. But that's not all.
