Dr. Usera said his research indicates that tagging other people in LinkedIn posts can help boost engagement. "We kind of have this sense of professionalism in terms of how you're supposed to post, how you're supposed to interact, and the topics are generally professional in nature," he said.

**A Dallas megadonor, a new nonprofit, and the war on 'housing first':** Hannah Lebovits (College of Architecture, Planning, and Public Affairs) spoke with the [Texas Observer](#) about homelessness in Dallas and the narrative that homelessness and crime in the downtown area have led to the loss of business and economic prosperity. **Texas midterm elections:** Brent Boyea (College of Liberal Arts) spoke with [KERA](#) about John Cornyn's U.S. Senate race. Dr. Boyea explained that the \$7 million Cornyn raised in the last quarter of 2025 will help separate Cornyn from his Republican primary opponents. "For Cornyn, he's going to have to kind of play up to the messaging that he's worked for Texas and brought good jobs back to Texas," he said.
