## Changes to Teams Recordings and Upgrades to Stream

On **August 14**, Microsoft will change where recordings of Teams meetings are stored and how they are shared. This update will provide easy access to recordings and better integration with O365 applications. It will provide a simplified way to manage recordings and the same sharing experience as with other OneDrive files.

Certain features that were in Stream will be temporarily unavailable during 2021. Microsoft is expected to add these features back in during 2022, though certain features may be restored ahead of schedule.
