You will need to document your status by providing a separate supporting determination from the appropriate authority you indicated by your YES answer in Step Six of the 2026-2027 FAFSA student section (i.e., high school district homeless liaison, director of a TRIO or GEAR UP program, director of an emergency or transitional shelter, etc.). Please note that the supporting documentation you submit must show the authority's determination of your status as of 7/1/2025 or later to be valid for the 2026-2027 year.
