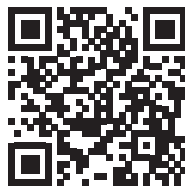
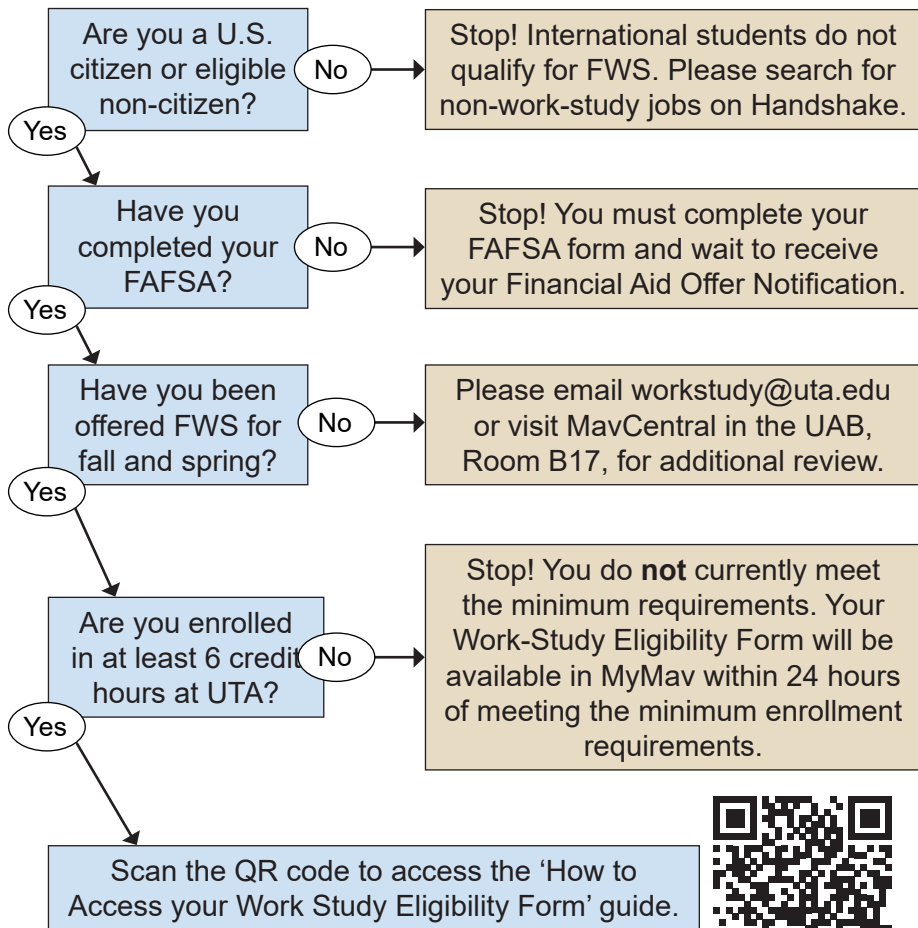

Quick Facts About Federal Work-Study (FWS)

- FWS eligibility is determined by your FAFSA each year.
- Students are not permitted to work during their scheduled class times.
- Students cannot work more than 19 hours per week.
- Students must maintain half-time (6+ credit hours) to remain eligible.
