

# NSSE 2024 Topical Module Report HIP Quality

The University of Texas at Arlington

Building on a Lumina Foundation-funded study, this module explores how High-Impact Practices (HIPs) integrate key elements believed to enhance their educational value, providing tools to assess both the quality and equity aspects of these HIP experiences. Students who reported on the core NSSE that they had engaged in at least one HIP were asked a series of detailed questions about their experiences. In contrast, students who had not participated in any HIPs were invited to describe another significant learning experience they had encountered.
