The renovation and expansion of the Life Sciences Building, which began in 2023, is well underway. Scheduled for completion in fall 2027, the project will transform the facility into a modern hub for teaching, research and student collaboration.

Key features include:

- Nearly 88,000 square feet of new space
- State-of-the-art research and teaching labs
- Expanded classroom facilities
- Multiple student engagement areas
- Upgraded electrical, plumbing and safety systems
