UTA Scholarship Deadline Approaching

Each academic year, The University of Texas at Arlington awards more than \$40 million in scholarships to support students in achieving their educational goals. The deadline to be considered for merit-based scholarships for the 2026-2027 academic year is March 1.

To qualify, students must submit all required admission documents to UTA Admissions by the March 1 deadline. This includes completing and submitting the Self-Reported Transcript and Academic Record (STARS). Students who meet these requirements are automatically considered for merit-based scholarships-no separate scholarship application is required.

We encourage you to remind your students to submit their application and STARS well before the deadline to ensure they do not miss out on these valuable scholarship opportunities.
