


Minors in Laboratories or Similar Facilities at UTA

Laboratory Tours

Mentor consults Laboratory Supervisor to:

- establish the date of the tour
- select and arrange the research / scholarly / artistic activities that will occur during the tour
- establish laboratory specific guidelines/protocols

Mentor consults Environmental Health and Safety (EH&S) for max # of Minors who can participate in the laboratory tour at one time

Mentor assigns Monitor(s) for covered Minors for the tour
