






# Minors in Laboratories or Similar Facilities at UT Arlington

(Covered Minors: 10 - 18 years old)

## Covered Activities



BSL = Biosafety level  
ACF = Animal care facilities



Mentor consults Laboratory Supervisor to:

- establish the dates when Minor can participate in covered activities
- Select and list the research / scholarly / artistic activities that the Minor can participate
- establish laboratory specific guidelines / protocols

Mentor consults Environmental Health and Safety (EH&S) for

- mandatory safety training for Minor(s)
- max # of Minors who can participate in covered activities in the laboratory at any one time

Mentor selects and appoints **one Monitor for every 10 covered Minors**

Mentor

- collects signed Consent Form (Form 8-90) from each covered Minor participating in the covered activities
- ensures that Consent Form for each covered Minor participating in covered activities and other appropriate documentation are retained by the laboratory's Department

Mentor completes Authorization for Minors in Laboratory Form (Form 8-91) and gets approval from:
