BEFORE YOU ARRIVE



BUILDING ASSIGNMENT & MOVE IN INFORMATION

Sign up for a move-in appointment on the UTA Housing Portal, available the first Friday of August. A confirmation will be sent to you via your UTA Email for your date and time. Appointments are available for Friday, Aug. 15, from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Note: Apartment numbers will be provided at check in



CHECK IN WITH YOUR ROOMMATES

Be sure to discuss with your roommate(s) what each of you are bringing. Contact information will be made available in the Housing Portal the first Friday of August.



MAP OUT DIRECTIONS

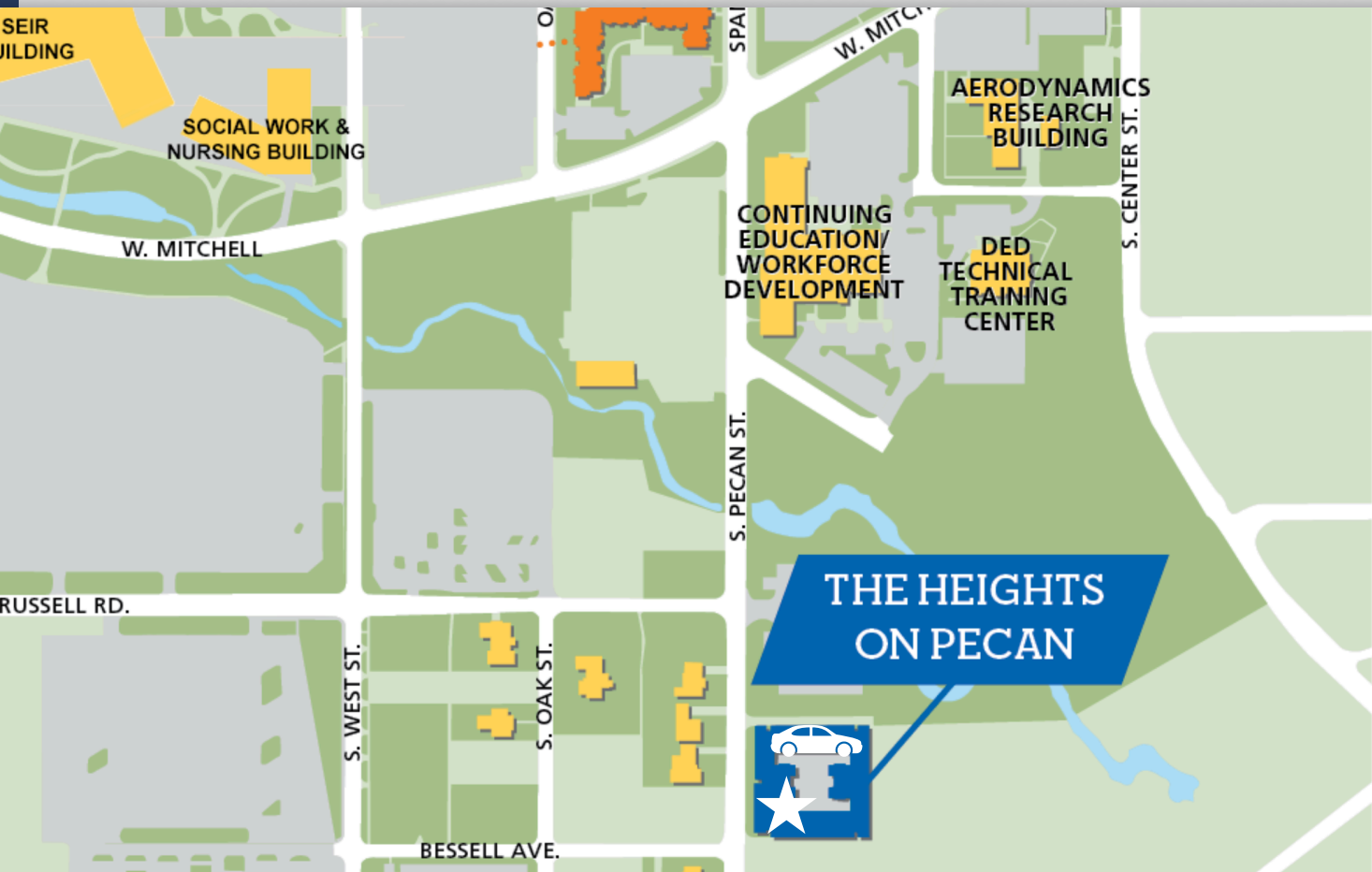

PARKING INSTRUCTIONS

Students arriving to the campus for the 2025 Move-In Event should be mindful of the directions to arrive to campus, as well as the parking to make your move-in process a breeze!

HEIGHTS ON PECAN



★ = CHECK IN LOCATION



= PARKING LOCATION

Check In: Located inside the lobby of Heights on Pecan.

Parking: Parking is available both in the P1 and P2 parking garages, or on the north side of Heights on Pecan.

Arriving from the North (Interstate-30)

Take Cooper Street exit and travel south towards the campus. Travel through the campus, and take a left on W. Mitchell St and right on S. Pecan St.

Arriving from the South (Interstate-20)

Take Cooper Street exit and travel north towards the campus. Take a right on W. Mitchell St. as soon as you arrive at the campus, and then a right on S. Pecan St.

PARKING INSTRUCTIONS

Check In: Check in for all apartments other than Heights on Pecan is located inside The Commons, on the west side of the campus and directly next to the West Campus Parking Garage.

Parking: Parking is available for check in at the West Campus Parking Garage. After you have checked in and picked up your keys, you can park at your apartment community. A map is provided at check in.

Arriving from the North (Interstate-30)

Take Cooper Street exit and travel south towards the campus. take a right at UTA Blvd (when you see the UTA Gateway Tower. Then take a left on W. Nedderman Dr. and a right into the parking garage. You can also park across the street from garage on the east side.

Arriving from the South (Interstate-20)

Take Cooper Street exit and travel north towards the campus. Take left at UTA Blvd and a left at W. Nedderman Dr. You will then turn right into the parking garage.

UNIVERSITY FURNITURE

BY BED FURNISHED APARTMENTS

By Bed Units (Timber Brook, The Lofts (2BR) and The Heights on Pecan come pre-furnished with everything to get you started. Items include living room furniture, a bed and desk in the unit, and other various items. Bed sizes change by community, so check UTA.edu/housing for a list of bed sizes on their community pages.

WALLS & CEILINGS

Televisions may not be mounted to walls. Contact paper, corkboard, upholstery fabric, or wallpaper may not be used on walls, shelves, or furniture. No structural or electrical alterations (including the installation of ceiling fans) may be made.

GET TO KNOW YOUR SPACE

Residence Director (RD)

A full-time, live-in professional staff member dedicated to your apartment community. Residence Directors oversee daily operations, supervise Resident and Office Assistants, support students with personal or academic concerns, coordinate engaging hall activities, address facilities issues, and help maintain a safe, respectful environment.

Community Coordinator (CC)

A student leader who works to assist the Residence Director's on a daily basis. The CC's are previous RA's who have shown excellent leadership skills and were great role models to their peers. CC's help manage front desk operations with our OA's and ensure that our communities are always headed in the right direction.

Resident Assistant (RA)

Student leaders who live in the apartments and are here to support you. Each RA is assigned to a specific area and helps build a strong, welcoming community. They plan events, offer support, connect residents to campus resources, help with check-in/out, and uphold university policies.

HOW TO USE THEM IN YOUR APARTMENT COMPLEX

LAUNDRY ROOM ETIQUETTE

The laundry room at University Village is a shared space, so keep it clean and be considerate. Don't leave laundry sitting too long, and wait a bit before reporting unclaimed clothes. Wet clothes left out can cause mildew, so be timely. Sharing the space fairly and using good manners makes it better for everyone!

HOW TO WASH YOUR LAUNDRY

1. **Sort Clothes:** Separate whites, darks, and colors.
2. **Check Pockets:** Empty them before washing.
3. **Add Detergent:** Follow the instructions.
4. **Load Washer:** Don't overfill it. Fill it 3/4ths of the way max.
5. **Pick Cycle:** Use "Normal" for most clothes, "Delicate" for fragile items.
6. **Start Washer:** Hit start and wait for it to finish.
7. **Move to Dryer:** Transfer clothes right away.
8. **Set Dryer:** Use low heat for colors, high for towels.
9. **lean Up:** Wipe down the machines and clean the lint.

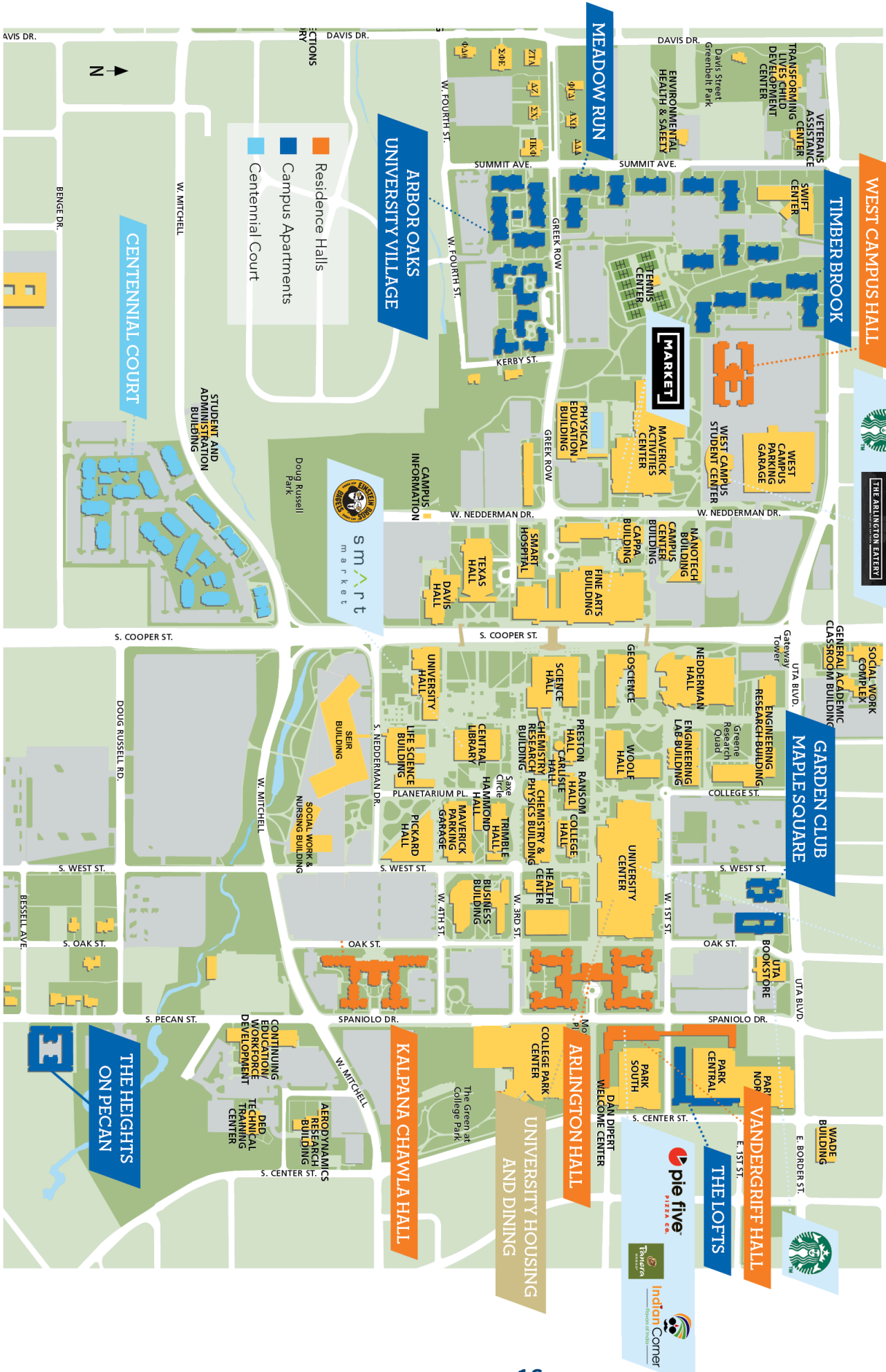
