The 18-credit minor in Museum Studies at the UT Arlington provides students from a variety of disciplines the opportunity to study and explore topics related to the Fine Arts Museum system, including Administration and Leadership, Collections and their Management, Community Outreach, Curatorial Design and Exhibition Display, Fundraising, Interpretation of Thematic Ideals, and Security and Sustainability. The minor is intended to complement any major at UTA; however, it is especially relevant to individuals studying Art, Art Education, Art History, Architecture, Business, Communication, History, and Library Sciences.

Note: Prerequisites for courses are completion of two courses from ART 1309, 1310, and/or 1317 or program instructor approval. *For non-Art majors, such as History and Anthropology, program instructors may allow for an equitable exchange of prerequisites if your area's course equivalents are completed. Please contact the program instructors/minor coordinators for Museum Studies for more information and approvals.
