Qualified candidates must hold a master's degree in business administration, or information systems, or a related field. Industry experience is preferred but is not a requirement for admission. Students must score at least 50th percentile on both the Verbal and Quantitative sections of the GMAT/GRE to be considered. International students who do not have a degree from a US university are also required to take the TOEFL.
