

Find the Ally Indicators

Ally indicators are color dials located next to course files. These dials indicate the file's level of accessibility and can help you prioritize which files to fix first. **Students cannot see these indicators.*

Hovering over the indicators lets you see the accessibility score: low, medium, or high.



Click on the indicator to see the percentage score, specific issues affecting the file, and instructions for improving the file.



- 2 View all the file's accessibility issues

Once you have corrected the specific issues affecting the file, the accessibility percentage score will change.
