## **Graduation Checklist for Master's Non-thesis or Thesis Substitute students**

This list is for student use only and is not to be submitted to the Graduate Program Coordinator at any time.

Enroll in at least one graduate level class in your program of study.
Meet with your graduate advisor to ensure that you will have met all departmental and university requirements for graduation this semester.
Submit an <b>Application for Graduation</b> to the graduate school by the deadline indicated in the graduate catalog for the semester in which you are graduating (usually within 30 days of the first day of class).
If you are completing a project or taking comp exams as your final exam requirement, submit a copy of the <b>Final Master's Exam Report</b> , to the Graduate Program Coordinator. You must <i>unconditionally pass</i> this exam before the end of the semester.
Complete all course and exam requirements.
Earn a 3.0 or better as your overall graduate GPA and GPA in your major.
