Research hours cannot be applied to the minor and only 6 hrs will count towards emphasis, additional hours will count as advanced electives.

## Internship in Psychology

Students may complete internship hours to count towards Psych Emphasis or as electives. The student must meet required prerequistes: PSYC 2300, 3300, 3200, GPA 3.2 and relevant prereqs. Student must also obtain permission from the professor and complete the Internship Form.
