PARKING DETAILS

REGISTER FOR AN EVENT PARKING PERMIT

All vehicles parking on campus will require a permit. Follow the instructions below to claim your event parking permit.

- 1. Scan the QR code on the right
- 2. Select "Purchase Event Permit"
- 3. Select "Department-Hosted Event"
- 4. Select "Friends & Family Weekend 2025"
- 5. Enter voucher code: FFW2025
- 6. Select permit type "(EVT-COMP) UTA Friends & Family Weekend"
- 7. Select the active date
- 8.Add vehicle info and confirm



DOWNLOAD THE TRIPSHOT APP

The UTA MavMover shuttle buses will run for Friends & Family Weekend on Saturday, 10-18-2025. We encourage all Friends & Family Weekend attendees to download the TripShot app to track the arrival times of the MavMover shuttles.

- 3. Select University of Texas at Arlington


PARKING RECOMMENDATIONS

FRIDAY OCTOBER 17TH

- If you're stopping by the UTA Studio Arts Center for their annual sale and glass blowing demonstrations, we recommend parking at Lot 27 located off of Davis Drive.
- If you have registered for the tour at AT&T Stadium at 10:00am, you will park at AT&T Stadium in Blue Lot 1 or Blue Lot 2. The address for AT&T Stadium is 1 AT&T Way, Arlington, TX 76011.
- When you arrive for check-in at University Center, we recommend parking in lots 38, 39, or the garages (Park North, Central, or South).

SATURDAY OCTOBER 18TH

- When you arrive for check-in on Saturday, we recommend parking in lots F11, F12, 38, 39, or the garages (Park North, Central, or South).
- If you would like to park near the College Park Center for the volleyball game, we recommend parking in the Park South garage.
- If you're stopping by the UTA Studio Arts Center for their annual sale and glass blowing demonstrations, we recommend parking at Lot 27 located off of Davis Drive.
- If you would like to drive to the Maverick Activities Center for a tour of the facility and participate in the Maverick Family Games Competition, we recommend parking in Lot 34 or the West Campus Garage located off of Nedderman Drive.
- If you would like to go to the UTA Planetarium, we recommend parking in Lot F10 off of S. West Street.
